Job title: Editorial Fellow

Duration: 6 months

The duties of the successful candidate will include:

- Working in a busy national newsroom, reporting on a wide range of stories including politics, crime, health, science and environment.
- Interviewing people both virtually and face to face with a view to identifying the best news angles.
- Reporting in a range of different writing styles, including blog posts, breaking news, longer form news stories and features.
- Using data, pictures, video and graphics to produce informative and engaging interactive content.
- Working closely with the Independent's audience team to use SEO, analytics and trends to promote stories.

- Proven writing and research skills
- Demonstrative commitment to working in the media.
